GL CREAM

GL CREAM is a scientifically blended cream designed to remove stubborn mineral deposits, chlorine damage, soap scum, hard water stains, rust and other unsightly and hazardous accumulations on polished glass or porcelain tiles surface

USES:

Recommended for use on polished surface, granite, porcelain, ceramic tiles, glass and mirror

COVERAGE:

Approximately 20 ft² to 54 ft² per 1 kg container depending on age of stains, and surface wear condition, temperature, humidity, and method of application

METHOD OF APPLICATION:

1. **Read entire label before using**
2. **TEST A SMALL AREA** according to application instructions to determine desired results
3. Ensure surface is clean, dry and free of existing coatings
4. Apply a small amount (tablespoon or less) of GL Cream directly onto glass surface area
5. Using soft cotton or #0 Steel Wool, buff Master GL Cream directly onto glass surface until becomes clear and nearly dry
6. Clean surface with water and polish dry completely with soft cotton or absorbent towel
7. Repeat process if necessary until desired results are achieved. A hand-held buffer with soft bonnet may be used for quicker results for larger area

MAINTENANCE:

Master PH Cleaner is recommended for ongoing maintenance to remove hard water deposit build up

LIMITATIONS:

Severely damaged or deep scratches on polished surface may require professional attention or replacement. Do not allow product to come in contact with any non-recommended surface



HANDLING AND STORAGE:

- Keep container closed
- Store in original container only
- Unused, stored product is freeze-thaw stable

CAUTION:

- **KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**
- Eye protection and rubber gloves recommended during application
- **IF INGESTED:** Do not induce vomiting. Drink large quantity of water. Seek immediate medical attention
- **IF INHALED:** Move to fresh air
- **EYE CONTACT:** Flush thoroughly with water for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lens if wearing. Seek immediate medical attention
- **SKIN CONTACT:** Flush thoroughly with plenty of water and then wash skin with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing. If irritation persists, get medical attention
